Getting Here

At the Burwell Center for Career Achievement, we pride ourselves in being at the forefront of environmental efficiency. On track to receive LEED Platinum status, our building uses 60% less energy than a conventional building of the same size. Leading the University of Denver in environmental sustainability, we encourage all our guests to consider diverse transportation options. Please see our suggestions below:

Public Transit: The Burwell Center is just an 11-minute walk (1/2 mile) away from the University of Denver RTD Stop. The E, F, and H light rail lines service this station from Union Station, Downtown, Aurora, or Ridgegate with stops along the I-25 corridor. The 24 bus also serves the station to and from University Blvd. The 21 bus serves Evans Ave.

Bicycle: Bicycle usage is encouraged on campus, and there are bike racks on the east side of the building. We suggest wearing a helmet and using a U-Lock to secure your bicycle.

Car/ Driving: We understand that sometimes driving is the most logical option. Below are the suggested public parking facilities that visitors can use. For short (1 hour or less) stays, there is paid street parking or some time limited neighborhood parking. Please observe the signs.
